



Dear New Kindergartener and Elementary Families;

Welcome to Day-After-Day! I hope that you all are enjoying a healthy and happy summer. I wanted to send you some information that you will find helpful as we all get ready for another school year.

Kindergarteners

The first day of Day-After-Day will be the first day of school. We will meet the kindergarteners who are enrolled for that day at 12:30 in the back lobby (outside Lisa Seyferth's classroom). Please note that the kindergarten classrooms are split on that Thursday and Friday. Please let us know which of those days your child will be attending D.A.D.

Monday, September 9, and for the entire month of September, all kindergarteners will be dismissed at 12:30. I will keep track of the extra hours for you child. You will be billed \$5.00/hour and will be given a bill for these extra hours at the end of September. This fee will be separate from the monthly fee that you will contract with me during the first week in September. The Apples/Bananas schedule will not start until the first week of October. Please send them with a lunch and a drink. We provide snack every day at 3:30. The kindergarten coordinator is Jeannie Furness. Bill Young and Lia Berman will also be working with your children. Kindergarteners are assigned their own cubby in our room. I ask that you send a change of clothes as well as a smock for your child. Please label all clothing with their name.

Elementary Students

We will meet the elementary students in the back lobby at 3:00 on the first day of school. We will be expecting all the students who are enrolled for that day. If your child will not be attending D.A.D. on that first day, please call and let us know.

Tuition Contracts

I divide the school year into 10 monthly payments. You will fill out a contract with me during the first week of school. Payments are due the first week of each month. Again, welcome to our Program. The Day-After-Day teachers and I look forward to having your child (children) as part of the Day-After-Day family! Should you have any questions or concerns please feel free to call. I check messages frequently during the summer. We will be in our room setting up during the last week of August. I shall be sending out a detailed newsletter during the first few weeks of September, but wanted to send this note to help alleviate any anxieties regarding your child's first day of after school. Hopefully I have done that. For now, enjoy the rest of the summer and remember: September will be here soon!
